

## VetView 2.0 Privilege Changes (Schedules)

For our new Schedule system, we attempted to utilize the existing privileges as much as possible. For the majority of our users, system access will continue exactly as it did in version 1.7.

### Schedule Appointments / Client Coordinators / Front Desk

For those staff members who manage the appointments for each unit on a daily basis, these privileges should be enough to add appointments, add or edit time slots, add details, etc.

### Schedule Management / Unit Managers

In 2.0, many of the Schedule Management features were placed directly on the schedule screen itself. This feature now allows users to copy and paste time slots, days, weeks, save and apply day or week templates, and show / hide schedules (the feature formerly known as Active Time Log.)

All other privileges under this have been deprecated, and their non-schedule screen features moved to Hospital Setup.

Any users who had Schedule Management in Version 1.7 will retain this privilege in 2.0
